



## EMERGENCY CODES

<b>Code</b>	<b>Description</b>	<b>Response</b>
<b>Yellow</b> Disruptive / Dangerous Behavior	A person(s) has become verbally and/or physically assaultive and may have a weapon	Keep your distance from the assailant. Dial *** and report CODE YELLOW INTRUDER and location
<b>Green</b> Psychiatric Intervention	A psychiatric patient or disruptive person has become verbally and/or physically assaultive	Keep a safe distance from the person. Dial *** and report CODE GREEN and location
<b>Red</b> Fire	Fire, smoke or odor of something burning. Dial *** and pull the nearest fire alarm box	RACE: Rescue those in immediate danger Activate the alarm Contain the fire (close the doors) Extinguish the fire, if safe to do so. Otherwise, Evacuate
<b>Blue</b> Cardiac/respiratory arrest	Cardiac or Respiratory arrest	Assess for unresponsiveness, breathing. Dial *** to report
<b>Pink</b> Neonatal Arrest	Neonatal Arrest	Notify RN or Charge nurse
<b>Purple</b> Infant Abduction	Infant Abduction	Notify RN or Charge nurse

**Dial \*\*\* for all codes: except SMV, dial 50: and SCOR Villas & Sub-acute III dial 911 for code blue**

- **State your name**
- **Repeat information twice.**
